Parent Teacher Interviews

Parent-Teacher Interviews will be offered in-person, by telephone or video conference. They will be held on Tuesday, October 17th and Thursday, October 19th from 3:30pm-6:30pm each evening. We are using the same School Interviews program where parents/guardians can book their appointments online. This is a proactive approach to achieving student success. Discussions will focus on how your child is doing academically and socially. Teachers will share specific information about assessments completed and will present any behavior concerns that may be affecting the student's success in school. Parents and students in turn will have the opportunity to express any concerns they may have. If these dates do not work for you, please contact your child(ren)'s teacher to make other arrangements.

Please note: You will receive an email from the school with the link to book your appointment(s) using the School Interviews website. This program has worked very well for us in the past and it makes it easier for parents/guardians to book interviews using your phone, tablet or computer. If you do not have access to technology you can contact the school and we will book your interview for you.
