Kindergarten Registration

Kindergarten registration forms for the 2025/26 school year are available. If you currently have children attending Darwell School and will have a child entering kindergarten next year, please contact the school, and a package will be sent home. To be eligible for kindergarten, your child must be 5 years of age by December 31, 2025. We require a copy of your child's birth certificate, proof of address (ie. utility bill, property tax notice, rental agreement), and your rural address sign number. The registration package is also available online. If you have completed the forms, please bring them to the school as soon as possible.

Grade 6 PAT Tests

The week of June 9-13, the grade 6 class will complete field tests for the province in Social Studies and Science instead of Provincial Achievement Tests. The following are the dates the grade 6 students will be writing their other PAT tests:

Friday, June 20 - ELAL Part B Tuesday, June 24 - Math Part A Wednesday, June 25 - Math Part B

The purpose of the PAT is to determine if students are learning what they are expected to know; report to Albertans on how well students have achieved provincial standards at given points in their schooling; and to assist schools, authorities, and the province in monitoring and planning to improve student learning. Please encourage your children to eat healthy, get a good night's rest and come to school ready to do their best. All tests will begin at 9am.
