#### **PowerSchool**

This is the program that parents use to see their child's progress in school, as well as attendance information. If you have not logged into PowerSchool, a link is available on our school website, located on the right side of the homepage. The first time you log in, you will need to do it from a laptop or computer; after that, you can access the information on other devices. If you have lost your username or password, please contact the office, and we can send that information to you. New students to our school will be receiving an information letter as well as username and password information shortly.

#### **Reporting Student Absences**

Please report if your child will be absent from school the morning of the absence (or the day prior if you have an appointment scheduled). There are a few ways you can contact the school. Go to our website (www.darwellschool.ca) scroll down the homepage "Attendance Notification", you will simply choose Darwell School or Mrs. Stark (Secretary) as the contact, enter the absence information and submit. #### **Transportation**
